Runway – slips and trips	Athletes slipping or tripping due to wet or gritty surface, or obstructions on the runway	 Ensure runway is free of grit, dirt, leaves and standing water If wet/raining, ensure drainage areas around the runway are kept clear Sweep runway to remove excess water, grit, leaves or dirt Ensure no obstructive "check marks" are on the runway Ensure all Javelin throws are supervised so athletes only throw when the runway is clear Ensure measuring tapes do not encroach upon the runway Ensure runway has no badly worn or damaged areas 	L	•	L	Field Referee (Throws) and Lead Official

		throw, all officials forward of the throwing line must stand outside the sector lines and face the thrower • Ensure only officials are allowed forward of the throwing line, except if athletes are allowed to retrieve under supervision • Implements must only be returned by hand, with the Javelin(s) held vertically • Ensure the warning horn is sounded (and acknowledged by officials/helpers) to warn that a throw is about to commence • Ensure that throws commence only when the supervising official signals to the athlete that				Official
